- TERMS & CONDITIONS



- You **MUST** include a copy of your Public Liability Certificate of Currency with your application form. This insurance must be submitted to the Secretary no later than 7 days prior and stalls will be refused permission to setup if not received.
- **Gates open at 6:30am. No vehicles may enter Showgrounds after 9am. For safety reasons, strictly no movement of traffic (cars, trucks, bikes, trailers etc) within Showgrounds between 9:30am and 4pm (emergency and maintenance vehicles excepted).** You are responsible for your own safety and for the safety of other users of the Showgrounds at all times during the set-up period.
- Stall holders will receive a site number and map on arrival. Sites may not be the same as previous years. Please ensure you setup within your designated site area marked (including ropes etc).
- Once setup, stall holders must park their cars in the designated parking areas.
- All stalls must be setup according to Callington A & H Society Safety Specifications. A Safety Officer will be in attendance.
- You must comply with all directions from the Safety Officer, Show Staff, Security, Police or Emergency Services.
- Stall holders must adhere to any health regulations as directly by SA Health at the time of the event.
- Stall holders are to supply their own trestles and extension cords (maximum 20m length).
All electrical cords and appliances must be tested and tagged to comply with [SafeWork SA standard 3760](#)
- It is the responsibility of the stall holders to **clear away all rubbish at the end of the day**. Please recycle as much as possible. Skip bins are provided at the rear of the Show Office for free disposal of any rubbish. Small garbage bins around the oval are for patrons use only.
- All Applications are due 30 days prior to the Show and supporting documents must be received as soon as possible (documents and payments will not be accepted less than 7 days prior to the Show).
- Receipts and wristbands will be forwarded as confirmation of site booking once all documents have been received.
- Approval of any late applications will be at the discretion of the Oval Convenor. Trade Stalls paid after this time must pay admission for ALL staff in addition to the stall fee.
- NO refunds will be given unless notified at least 21 days prior to Show Day unless cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances (ie COVID or extreme illness).
- **No raffles, lotteries, sale of bingo tickets or show bags are permitted.**
- Items **banned** by the Federal Council of Agricultural Shows are NOT permitted at the show.
- Callington A & H Show has a **NO DOG policy**. Service/Companion dogs exempted (proof of exemption required).
- Callington A & H Show reserves the right to reject any application for trade space.
- Callington A & H Show will not be liable in any way for any expenditure or losses, including consequential loss, incurred, or sustained by you in the event of partial or total loss of services at this show.

Site applicants must submit the following to secure their booking:

- Complete and Sign Trade Stall Application Form
- Payment made in FULL
- Public Liability Certificate of Currency valid on Show Day
- Food Business Notification Certificate from SA Health or your local Council (Food/Drink Vendors ONLY)
