## CALLINGTON A & H SOCIETY INCORPORATED - TERMS & CONDITIONS

### CATERING, TRADE AND DISPLAY SITE APPLICATIONS

- All Catering and Trade Site Applications must be submitted online via the [Callington Show website](#). All enquiries please email [sites@callingtonshow.com.au](mailto:sites@callingtonshow.com.au). To apply for a Display Only Site email [sites@callingtonshow.com.au](mailto:sites@callingtonshow.com.au).
- Applicants will be notified by email if their application is approved. Invoices will be then forwarded to approved applicants.
- You **MUST** include a copy of your Public Liability Insurance for a minimum of \$10,000,000. Your current Certificate of Currency must be submitted online with your application form. If your current policy expires before Show Day you are required to send us your renewed Certificate of Currency [sites@callingtonshow.com.au](mailto:sites@callingtonshow.com.au) at least 7 days prior to the Show.
- All Catering and Trade sites providing samples and/or selling any Food or Beverage **MUST** provide a Food Business Notification Number (FBN). Forms available from your local Council or SA Health [Food Business Notification Form](#)
- In addition to the FBN the Mount Barker District Council requires anyone providing samples and/or selling any Food and/or Beverage to complete the [Temporary Food Stall Notification Form](#) online and submit to Council at least 14 days **PRIOR** to the show. The Council's Environmental Health Officers will be on site on the day to conduct food safety inspections of food stalls/vans. Please retain a copy of your FBN acknowledgement as evidence of notification for both the Council and event organisers.
- Stall holders must provide their own shelter (such as a marquee), along with any trestles, tables, chairs, and other equipment required to set up and maintain their site. All marquees must be securely anchored using pegs (300–400 mm in length) and/or weights (minimum 20 kg on each pole), as robust anchoring is essential for safety. It is recommended that stallholders use higher-quality marquees to ensure better protection for their products.
- We are a 'Plastic Free Show'! Please bring eco-friendly, biodegradable alternatives for your stall.
- All electrical appliances including cables, extension cords (maximum 20m length) and power boards **MUST** be tested and tagged to comply with [SafeWork SA standard 3760](#).
- If using gas you **MUST** download and complete the [SA Gov Gas Safety: Event details form](#) and submit via email at least 4 weeks prior to the show.
- Stall holders will receive their entry wristbands, a site number and map on arrival. Note it is your responsibility to distribute any additional wristbands purchased to your staff. Sites may not be the same as previous years. Please ensure you set up within your designated site area marked (including ropes, etc).
- Additional entry wristbands not pre-ordered with your site application must be purchased at the gate at full cost.

- Approval of any late applications will be at the discretion of the Oval Convenor.
- NO refunds will be given unless notified at least 21 days prior to Show Day unless cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances (ie COVID or extreme illness).
- **No raffles, lotteries, sale of bingo tickets or show bags are permitted.**
- Items **banned** by the Agricultural Shows of Australia are **NOT** permitted at the show (see attached list).
- Callington A & H Show has a **NO DOG policy**. Service/Companion dogs exempted (proof of exemption required).
- Callington A & H Show reserves the right to reject any application for Food, Beverage or Trade space.
- Callington A & H Show will not be liable in any way for any expenditure or losses, including consequential loss incurred, or sustained by you in the event of partial or total loss of services at this show.

### **CALLI TRAIL**

- Calli Trail applications must be received by 13th September to be included on the trail.
- Stall holders are responsible for supplying promotional items unless negotiated otherwise.
- Physical items should be of reasonable value. We will not accept 'buy one, get one free' vouchers but will allow discount vouchers if included with a physical product.
- All applications will be subject to approval by the committee as spots are limited on the trail.
- Participating sponsors are required to provide either 250 child/family bag items and/or 75 deluxe bag items (or 325 items total).

### **ON SHOW DAY**

- **Gates open at 6:30am.**
- **No vehicles may enter Showgrounds after 9am.**  
**For safety reasons, strictly no movement of traffic (cars, trucks, bikes, trailers etc) within the Showgrounds between 9:15am and 4pm (emergency and maintenance vehicles excepted).** You are responsible for your own safety and for the safety of other users of the Showgrounds at all times during the set-up period.
- Once set up, stall holders **MUST** park their cars in the designated parking areas.
- All stalls must be set up according to Callington A & H Society Safety Specifications. A Safety Officer will be in attendance.
- You must comply with all directions from the Council Health Officer, Safety Officer, Show Staff, Security, Police or Emergency Services.
- Stall holders must adhere to any health regulations as directed by SA Health at the time of the event.
- It is the responsibility of the stall holders to **clear away all rubbish at the end of the day**. Please recycle as much as possible. Skip bins are provided at the rear of the Show Pavilion for free disposal of any rubbish. Small garbage bins around the oval are for patron's use only.

Bouncing Beans  
Drug Related Goods (including Cocaine Kits, Bonges etc)  
Explicit and Hardcore T-Shirts  
Explicit DVD's & Videos  
Fake Cigarettes  
Fireworks - Crackers  
Fire Wallets  
Fuel Type Fire Lighters (Zippo)  
Horns and Trumpets  
Knives (including Pen Knives) (excluding appropriately packaged kitchenware sets)  
Laser Pointers, Pen Lights or Laser Toys  
Metal and wooden Martial Art Nunchakus  
Playing Cards (Nude or Lurid)  
Pressure Pack Snow  
Pressure Pack Fart Gas  
Silly String  
Stink Bombs  
Water Bombs

Toy Guns are acceptable; however, the following are NOT:

- Replica Guns and Pistols
- Ball Bearing Guns
- Gel Blaster Guns Eight Shot Caps
- Pellet Guns
- Pop Downs (Throw Downs)
- Potato Guns (Bullet Type)
- Roll Caps
